OUR SERVICES

Vaccinations: - Childhood & Travel vaccinations including yellow fever

Shared Antenatal Care with Hornsby Hospital is practiced by some of the doctors here.

Women's Health: - Pap smears, contraceptive advice including diaphragm fitting and Implanon insertion and hormone replacement therapy.

Minor Surgery: - Removal of skin cancers and cysts and suturing of lacerations. **All instruments are disposable or sterilised by autoclaving to prevent cross infection.**

Cryotherapy: - freezing of sun spots and warts with liquid nitrogen

Pathology: - Bulk-Billed at the local laboratory. Douglas Hanley Moir available Monday - Friday 8am – 12pm

Equipment: - Defibrillator / ECG / Spirometer / Nebulisers / Hyfrecator – on-site

Chaperone: – If you require a chaperone during a physical examination, please inform your doctor.

APPOINTMENTS

Our receptionists are available from 8.00am to make appointments. Waiting time will be minimal if patients are prompt and make appropriate appointments. Appointments can also be booked online through HotDoc.

The standard 15-minute appointment will be inadequate for Pap Smears, Insurance Medicals, Full physicals and multiple problems. So please ask for a long (half hour) appointment for these.

Sick children and emergencies are given priority & will be attended to by the first available doctor.

We accommodate walk ins if it is an emergency or if there are available spots.

Remember late cancellations and missed appointments inconvenience other patients.

Please see any available doctor if your usual doctor is unavailable at a time convenient to you, as the doctors in this practice work as a team.

AFTER HOURS SERVICE/ HOME AND NURSING HOME VISITS

In an emergency ring **000** for an ambulance.

Our doctors will accommodate home visits & nursing home visits for their regular patients if necessary. National Home Doctor Service is an accredited Medical Deputising Service providing after hours service on **13 SICK (13 7425)** for home visits only, not medical advice. All visits are Bulk Billed, and your GP receives the report the next day. Some local bulk billing practices are open until 10 pm.

Note that our answering machine does not take messages.

FEE STRUCTURE

Consultation fees are displayed in the reception area.

- A normal consultation (15 mins) cost - **\$ 84.00** Saturday: **\$ 94.00**
- A long consultation (1/2 hr) cost - **\$150.00** Saturday: **\$160.00**

Childhood immunisations and other services provided by the Practice Nurse are bulk-billed. We are a private billing practice, but please speak to your doctor if you are experiencing financial difficulties. The doctors will advise you of other costs that may arise from your consultation especially if you are referred to another service provider.

Payments are to be made at the time of consultation by cash, cheque, EFT or credit card.

We are online with Medicare so we are able to submit claims on your behalf.

REMINDER SYSTEM

A reminder system is in operation to provide systematic preventative health care (eg. Cholesterol & blood pressure checks, diabetes review, abnormal pap smears and non-routine immunisations.) We also participate in the State/Territory Reminder Program. It is our policy to enrol patients in such systems, if you do not wish to participate then please inform your Doctor.

PATIENT RECORDS

We ensure that all patient records are kept secure and confidential. They are only available to authorised personnel. Your personal information is stored electronically at our practice. Our server is placed securely and locked. All programs are password protected and a confidential agreement is signed by each staff member. A copy of our Practice Policy is available on our notice board.

TELEPHONE COMMUNICATION

If considered appropriate, doctors will return phone calls as soon as possible but prefer not to be interrupted while they are in consultation. Urgent calls will be put through immediately to the doctor.

ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION

Our practice does not encourage any communication through email, although reasonable steps are taken to safeguard patient information, we inform patients that there may be a risk that it could be read by someone other than the intended recipient.

PRESCRIPTIONS & REFERRALS

By appointment only. In exceptional circumstances they will be issued but will incur a fee of \$10.00.

RESULTS

Patients will only be contacted if test results are concerning. Generally you will not be contacted if your results are normal but you are welcome to call for them. Please call the surgery between 10.00 am and 1.00pm or after 3.00pm for pathology results.
